The Denison Show Choirs traveled to Atlantic on Monday evening, Jan 30th for the Iowa High School Music Association's State Show Choir Contest. The Singing Ambassadors Varsity Show Choir earned a Division I rating, "Superior," which means their performance was outstanding in nearly every detail. The Sixteenth Street Singers Junior Varsity Show Choir earned a Division II rating, "Excellent," which means their performance had only minor defects.

The Singing Ambassadors performed a set based on the word "BEAT," including "Turn the Beat Around," "We Got the Beat," "Beat It," "You Can't Stop the Beat," and "Yesterday," by the Beatles.

The Sixteenth Street Singers performed a set based on friends, including "That's Where the Music Takes Me," "You've Got A Friend in Me," "Lean on Me," "One Tin Soldier," and "Stuck Like Glue."

Their next performances are at 20th Street Elementary and competition at Univ. of Neb. at Omaha.
