Comments by Coach Eller: "Defensively, we got caught up in a few screens by not talking and switching that led to layups or wide open jumpers. In the 2nd half, we gave up too many offensive rebounds and 2nd chance points. However, for the most part our defense was pretty solid and gave us a good chance to win the game. Offensively, we moved the ball well against their 2-3 zone and created good shots. We were able to get the ball inside early and get some baskets and we ran the floor well in transition early and got some layups following rebounds. Shenandoah then packed in their 2-3 zone even more to make it very difficult to get the ball inside. We had all the wide open perimeter shots we wanted, but we weren't able to make very many. We won't win any games scoring 31 points. There's nothing else to say except we didn't shoot well enough to win the game".
