Comments by Coach Eller: "I was very happy with the guys' effort tonight. Offensively, we struggled to run our sets, but we did a good job of attacking the basket off the dribble and we rebounded well offensively. We did not shoot the ball well at all, but we were aggressive and got a lot of layups attempts and free throw opportunities. We did a good job running the floor and got some layups in transition. We also did a good job of getting 2 of their starters into foul trouble, including their starting post player fouled out. Defensively, we did a good job of stopping their best ball handler from getting to the rim for layups, but we need to do a better job of communicating on defense - especially when screens are set as they had many open jumpers off simple ball screens. I thought we were the more aggressive team tonight and we were rewarded with a win for our aggressiveness. We have a long way to go and a lot of things to work on, but it was a good start to the season with a win over a team that had some good athletes".
