Comments by Coach Eller: "We made multiple mistakes running our offenses, which led to a lot of turnovers. Red Oak played tight defense on the ball, and our lack of ball handling skills led to more turnovers. Red Oak played good help defense when we got the ball inside and we got many of our shots blocked or altered instead of kicking out to the open player on the perimeter for an open shot. Defensively, Red Oak shredded our 2-3 zone defense in the 1st quarter, so we switched to man to man defense. We didn't communicate and got caught flat footed to give up easy baskets. We gave up a lot of layups in transition by not getting back when they got possession. Yeah, we went against some sophomores and juniors but that didn't have anything to do with all of the mental mistakes we made in the game or our lack of communication on defense. The guys just have to keep working on improving their skills and fundamentals to try to become better basketball players".
