Comments by Coach Eller: "IKM-Manning didn't beat us, instead we beat ourselves. Numerous unforced turnovers such as dropped passes, traveling with nobody guarding us and passing the ball out of bounds took away many offensive possessions - all of those turnovers happened because the guys panicked and tried to play too fast. We had at least 10 missed layups/shots inside 3 feet. Defensively, we did a good enough job to win until their last possession. If we stayed in zone defense, they would have gotten a wide open shot so we went to man to man defense, switching every screen, to give up no open shots. Instead, they run a simple screen up the lane from the block to the elbow and we don't talk on the screen, so we don't switch so they get a wide open layup with 2 seconds left to win the game. We had a nice 5 point lead with just over a minute left. We had an unforced turnover leading to a basket in transition, then we shoot 3 pointers twice without running any clock or even trying to run an offense. Our basketball IQ needs to get a lot higher in a hurry. Things that were talked about during timeouts weren't followed through on the court. It took almost an entire first half to even get into the right places on offense vs. their $\frac{3}{4}$ court pressure despite practicing for it yesterday and talking about it in the locker room before the game. We have to get more guys to be able to have the ball in his hands and make a good decision. Right now we have guys not wanting the ball at all or trying to do too much with the ball and ending up dribbling into traps. We also get tunnel vision and don't see our wide open teammates. When we got organized and got in the right places, we could make things happen. The guys have to be able to get into our offense and do what they are supposed to do instead of panicking and just running around without an organized plan".
