During the individual round, the boys were trying to recreate their baker experience. High games from some of the boys were Jake Fink with a 289, Ethan Totten with a 223, Grant Fink with a 213, Gavin Schmadeke with a 208, Jackson Steinkuehler with a 190, and Jett Paulsen with a 176. Jake

Fink was the only one to qualify for state placing 1st with a series of 687 with games of 186, 212, and 289. Jake's highlight of the day would have been his last game where he attempted to bowl another 300 game. He was able to get 10 strikes in a row, but in his 11th shot, he left one pin standing. Gavin Schmadeke placed 11th and was only 17 pins away from qualifying and Ethan Totten placed 16th and was only 28 pins away from qualifying. Grant Fink was actually in 7th going into the last game, but unfortunately dropped to 19th only 50 pins away from qualifying. We had four boys this year that have never bowled in the state qualifying meet before.
