Team Highlights

The Monarch Boys Bowling team won their State Qualifying Meet in Le Mars. This event is set up as 15 baker games with the top 2 teams advancing to the State Bowling Tournament in Waterloo next Tuesday. The Monarchs started slow with 175 and 171 before they figured out the lanes a bit better. Ending the first set with 212, 219 and 204. After the first set Monarchs trailed Le Mars by 21 and Lewis Central by 13. Switching lanes heading into the 2nd set of 5 games the boys were getting hot and determined to fight for the lead. Going 209, 192, 214, 226, and 235 the boys turned the tables and were now leading Le Mars by 91 and Lewis Central by 119. They were fired up heading into the last set. The lane change had different plans for them and put them to the test with several bad shots to shoot 158. After regrouping and settling down they went 202, 201, 196 and 220 to finish out the tournament pacing ahead of the field. Monarchs won with a score of 3034, 116 pins ahead of Lewis Central who narrowly beat Le Mars by 12 pins to take the 2nd qualifying spot.
