They placed 1st at their Monarch Baker Tournament, 3rd at the Hawkeye 10 conference tournament, and placed 1st at districts qualifying as a team for the state tournament. In the team portion of the state tournament, the boys were on fire. After 15 baker games, they were the 1st seed by 4 pins. Heading in the championship bracket as the 1 seed they swept Central Dewitt in 3 games. Heading into the Championship against 2nd ranked ADM they stayed hot and swept them in 3 games as well. Grant Fink, Logan Harper and Keaten Hartwig all competed individually at the state tournament. Grant Fink made the top 8 at the cut and was the 6 seed. After a heartbreaking match to go to the finals Grant ended up in 3rd place overall.
