

Creston 2, D-S Boys Soccer 0

Goals: 1) Creston's Brance Baker scored his 6th goal of the season with 27:41 remaining in the 1st half. Creston passed the ball over the top of the Monarch back line to Baker running the right corner. Baker beat the Monarch defender 1 on 1 and finished a 1 on 1 shot from 8 yards out into the upper 90 degree angle of the goal.

2) Creston's Aidan Anderson scored his 25th goal of the season with 17:37 remaining in the 1st half. Creston stole a pass from a Monarch defender leading to a 4 on 3 counter. Creston attacked the right wing and then centered a pass to Anderson who hit a 1 touch shot from 10 yards out.

The halftime score was Creston 2, D-S 0. The 2nd half was scoreless.

Comments by Carlos Trevino: "We dominated possession but we just couldn't finish any of our chances. We turned down too many decent opportunities for 1 touch shots. We had too many touches at times to try to get the ball perfect for a shot. By the time we do that, they have us marked up and we aren't open anymore. Creston's goalkeeper had a great game and he was especially aggressive on our corner kicks as we couldn't convert on any of our 12 opportunities there. Creston made us pay for 2 of our mistakes and they resulted in goals. They scored on 2 counters - 1 on long ball over the top and 1 on a steal. We had all of our midfield up in both situations, so the help defense wasn't there either time. Creston made multiple adjustments since we beat them in the regular season - most notably changing goalkeepers, changing their formation and moving players to different positions. That versatility really improved their team from earlier in the season. It was a tough way for the seniors and for me to end our careers. It's like a football game where we had 3 times the total offense but still lost the game. It seems to happen in soccer more than any other sport where the team that controls the game doesn't always win. We want to thank our seniors for the hard work they have put in over their careers".
