D-S falls to 6-3 this season, 4-1 in the Hawkeye 10

Goals: LC scored with 27:05 remaining in the 1st half. LC took a corner kick and D-S tried to clear the ball out of the box. D-S was unable to clear the ball and a LC midfielder had an open shot from 25 yards out that he put into the net.

The score at halftime was LC 1, D-S 0

Edin Barrios scored his 6th goal of the season, assisted by Griseldo Madera (1st assist) and Even Jeronimo (1st assist), with 16:31 remaining in regulation. Madera passed ball from the midfield high over the LC back line where Jeronimo beat the LC defender to the ball. Jeronimo passed the ball from the right wing across to Barrios running the left post, where Barrios finished from 5 yards out.

After 2 scoreless 10 minute overtime periods, the game went to 12 yard penalty kick shootouts. LC went 1st and made all 5 of their kicks, in alternating order. All 5 D-S players also made their shot: Manny Alcaraz, Ramon Perez, Carlos Garcia, Edin Barrios and Yahir Zavala.

Then the shootout went to the sudden victory 2nd round. LC made their 1st kick, Jose Lara made his kick, LC made their 2nd kick, Daniel Alcaraz made his kick, and LC made their 3rd kick. D-S' player put the shot on goal, but LC's keeper guessed right and made a diving save, ending the game.

Comments by Coach Trevino: "It was a fantastic soccer game played by both teams. Both teams played very well and really limited the scoring opportunities for their opponent. Both teams took turns possessing the ball really well. We had to change our formation at halftime because they had us outnumbered in the midfield and we weren't able to possess the ball much in the 1st half. They play with 7 in the midfield when they possess the ball as their 2 outside defenders come up to get involved in the offense, along with their 5 midfielders and 1 forward. We possessed the ball much better in the 2nd half, after our adjustment, and created better scoring opportunities. Both teams missed out on pretty good chances to score the winning goal in overtime. They hit the post on a counter where their midfielder was unmarked. We put one just wide when we had a 1 on 1 vs. their keeper. The penalty kicks were all good shots by both teams. It's rare to see 16 kicks on frame as often times shootouts are ended by a shot high, wide or off the post. We played our best soccer game of the season against a very good team. We need to build from this game. We showed we can play with anybody when we all do our job on the field".
