

Sergeant Bluff-Luton Boys Soccer 3, D-S 1
D-S falls to 6-4 this season

Shots: D-S 21, SB-L 16

Goals: SB-L scored the only goal of the 1st half with 6:03 remaining on a 1 touch from 4 yards out following a cross into the box from near the right corner.

SB-L increased the lead to 2-0 just 41 seconds into the 2nd half on a header from 2 yards out. SB-L took a corner kick from the right corner that was kicked to the left post, headed back to the middle and headed in.

Carlos Garcia scored the D-S goal on a penalty kick with 30:02 remaining in the match. D-S was awarded the penalty kick as the SB-L goalkeeper fouled a Monarch player inside the box.

SB-L scored the final goal on a 4 yard shot resulting from a long throw in on the right sideline that D-S was unable to clear.

Comments by Coach Trevino: "This game was a big letdown. As well as we played 2 nights earlier against Lewis Central, we played really poorly against SB-L. We continually turned the ball over forcing the ball down the middle of the field, which is where they put their best athletes and fastest players. We got caught watching the ball on defense and left people unmarked for open shots. We didn't clear the ball on defense a couple times and that led to goals for SB-L. We stood and watched the ball on offense instead of moving without the ball. The game was back and forth with both teams exchanging possession evenly. However, most of our shots came from 15 yards out or further, while SB-L created 7 shots from inside of 10 yards. SB-L did a much better job of spreading the field to create good scoring opportunities than we did. SB-L created a lot of corner kicks and crossing opportunities by attacking the sidelines and corners all game, while their players without the ball would move to open space and spread out very well. SB-L played very smart soccer against us".
