Comments from Head Coach Raegan Magnuson:

Right now, we have about a 30 second gap between each of our top runners, and continuing to shorten that gap is going to be a big focus for us moving forward. The closer we can keep our pack together, the better we can put ourselves in position as a team. Our high school girls competed hard in a very competitive field as well. Taelen Young led our girls with a 16th place finish, followed by Isabelle Blume (27th), Jocelin Garcia (29th), Brylee Eggeling (32nd), and Caroline Schrum (33rd). Jocelin and Addyson both stepped into different spots for us today and ran very gritty races. I really liked seeing our girls continue to look out for each other during the race. When they saw a teammate struggling, they stepped up and helped push them along. In the JV races, Ayvah Nemitz (6th), Alexandria Perez (15th) and Jorge Barajas (20th) all came home with medals today. Today gave us a really good look at where we are. We had some athletes put themselves in great positions and compete well, but we also saw some areas where we need to improve. For many of us, we are struggling through the middle portion of our races, and that is something we will continue to work on in practice.
