Denison improves to 2-2-1 this season and 2-1 in the Hawkeye 10 Conference

Goals: 1) Michelle Palma scored her 2nd goal of the season, assisted by Itzel Palma (1st assist of season) and Shelby Lima (1st assist of season) 2:12 into the match. Itzel dribbled the ball from the right corner towards the goal then she dropped a pass to Shelby who then 1 touched a pass to Michelle over by the left post who finished the shot from 8 yards out.

2) Shelby Lima scored her 1st goal of the season, assisted by Xochi Arellano (1st assist of season) with 26:21 remaining in the 1st half. Xochi took a shot on goal from 20 yards out that was blocked by their goalkeeper. Shelby crashed the shot and finished the rebound from 3 yards out by the left post.

3) Naomi Rivera scored her 1st goal of the season, assisted by Lorena Huerta (1st assist of season) with 22:09 remaining in the 1st half. Olivia DeVore played a pass down the right sideline to Ingrid Salas who attacked off the dribble. The ball was stolen from Salas but stolen right back by Lorena, who took a shot on goal from 15 yards out on the right wing that was blocked by the Tigers goalkeeper. Naomi crashed the rebound and finished from 6 yards out near the left post.

4) Shelby Lima scored her 2nd goal of the season, assisted by Xochi Arellano (2nd assist of season) with 16:50 remaining in the 1st half. Giana Garcia stole a pass from Red Oak and passed the ball to Michelle Palma, who passed to Xochi. Xochi dribbled by a Red Oak midfielder and passed a ball through the gap of the Tigers defense to Shelby who finished the 1 on 1 with the Tigers' goalkeeper just inside the left post from 25 yards out.

5) Alejandra Cardenas scored her 1st goal of the season, assisted by Itzel Palma (2nd assist of season), with 13:13 remaining in the 1st half. Jocelyn Serrato passed the ball to Xochi Arellano who passed the ball towards the right sideline to Itzel. Itzel passed the ball ahead to Alejandra running the right wing. Alejandra and the Tigers' goalkeeper got to the ball at the same time and the ball popped out, into the box, where Alejandra finished the shot from 4 yards out.

6) Xochi Arellano scored her 1st goal of the season, assisted by Jocelyn Serrato (1st assist of season) with 10:53 remaining in the 1st half. Xochi stole a pass from a Red Oak player and ran a give and go with Jocelyn and Xochi hit the shot from 25 yards out in the middle of the field.

7) Alejandra Aragon scored her 1st goal of the season, assisted by Ingrid Salas (1st assist of season) with 1:42 remaining in the 1st half. Maily Hernandez passed the ball from the left wing to Alejandra in the left corner. Alejandra switched a pass to Ingrid who took a shot on goal that

deflected off of a Tigers' defender back to Alejandra, who hit the shot from 4 yards out from outside the left post into the right side net.

8) Sicara Arevalo scored her 1st goal of the season, assisted by Giana Garcia (2nd assist of season) just 1:57 into the 2nd half. Denison completed a lot of short passes to advance the ball. Jocelyn Serrato passed the ball to Sicara on the left wing. Sicara and Giana ran a give and go and Sicara dribbled around the last defender then finished the shot from 10 yards out near the left post.

9) Giana Garcia scored her 1st goal of the season, assisted by Itzel Palma (3rd assist of season) with 35:23 remaining in the match. Amy Garcia dropped the ball to goalkeeper Belina Pancho who switched fields to Itzel Palma near the right sideline. Itzel dribbled the ball down the right sideline and centered a pass to Giana, who finished the 1 on 1 with their goalkeeper from 10 yards out.

10) Naomi Rivera scored her 2nd goal of the season, assisted by Olivia DeVore (1st assist of season) with 25:53 remaining and ending the game. Lorena Huerta passed the ball from the left sideline to Olivia on the left wing. Olivia switched a pass over the top of the Tigers defense to Naomi running the right post. Naomi finished the 1 on 1 with their goalkeeper from 8 yards out.

Comments by Coach Eller: "The girls played very well tonight. We really focused on passing accurately and quickly and tried to work more on 1 touch passing and using our drop passes. All of our goals were assisted and we played very unselfishly. Defensively, we stopped all of their counters early enough to keep them from taking shots. We got to have some fun with letting our forwards play defense and our defenders play forward. We continued to pass the ball well with the girls playing in the different positions. We had all 21 girls play a lot of minutes tonight and everybody who played was moving the ball well tonight. It was nice to see the girls have some fun and share the ball with each other so well".
