

Kuemper 2, D-S 1 (2 OT PK 4-3)
D-S falls to 3-8 this season, 1-4 in the Hawkeye 10

Shots: D-S 15, Kuemper 13
Shots on goal: Kuemper 13, D-S 8
Saves: Sam Chandler had 12 saves in the match and 3 more saves in the penalty kick shootouts for a total of 15 saves.

Goals: Kuemper scored just 2:11 into the match on a shot from 8 yards out following a crossing pass from the right corner to the left post that got through the entire D-S defense.

Libby Leon scored just 3:09 into the match on a shot from 23 yards out near the left post following a steal from a Kuemper defender trying to clear the ball away from Aremy Santos.

The remainder of regulation and both 10 minute overtimes were scoreless, so the match went into shootouts, with both teams alternating shots from the 12 yard penalty kick mark.

Kuemper kicked first and made 3 of their 5 kicks. 1 kick was saved by Sam Chandler. Denison had shots made by Karla Sanchez, Libby Leon and Aremy Santos.

After being tied 3-3 after the 1st round of shootouts, the shootout went to sudden victory shootouts. Kuemper's 1st 2 shots were saved by Sam Chandler. Denison's 1st 2 shots weren't on goal. Kuemper made their 3rd shot while D-S's 3rd shot was saved by Kuemper's goalkeeper, ending the match.

Comments by Coach Eller: "We made 1 mistake on defense very early and they made us pay for it. Otherwise, we played great defense all game, especially shutting down their speedy forward who had 12 goals this season coming into the game. We had 4 really good chances in regulation and overtime to score goals, but we were either off target from wide open shots 18-20 yards out or shot right to their keeper from about 10 yards out. Sam had 3 saves on good shots in the penalty kicks to give us a chance to win. We had 3 consecutive opportunities to win the game in the shootout, but we weren't able to put a shot past the keeper. This loss hurts not just because it's a conference loss, but also in my opinion we outplayed Kuemper, outpossessed Kuemper and created more chances to win".
