The 2nd goal came with 28 seconds left before halftime on a 1 touch shot from 8 yards out just outside the near post.

Comments by Coach Eller: "It was a good, back and forth soccer game that was pretty evenly played by both teams. We did a great job of not allowing any goals in the flow of play. I thought our defense was outstanding. Jimena Lupian, Jocelyn Serrato and Leilany Carrazco did a great job of picking up their counters and the players who attacked who weren't man marked. Xochi Arellano, Lynnae Johnson and Leilany Morales did a great job of marking their leading scorer and middle midfielder. Sam Chandler had some good saves again on some solid shots by Harlan players. Offensively, we created some opportunities for some shots against a team with good speed, but we had many of our counters stopped without getting a shot off.
