Goals: 1) Estela Lupian scored her 2nd goal of the season, assisted by Libby Leon (3rd assist of season) on a shot from 15 yards out just 4:18 into the match. Libby had the ball at the D-S 40 yard line and passed the ball over the top of the Carroll back line which Estela ran down and put the 15 yard shot from just outside the right hashmark to just inside the left post.

2) Hally Escobar scored her 2nd goal of the season, assisted by Estela Lupian (1st assist of season) on a 17 yard shot with 7:43 remaining in the 1st half. D-S countered a Carroll possession as Libby Leon received the ball and passed the ball down the right sideline which Estela ran down. Estela dribbled around 1 Carroll defender, drew another defender and centered the ball to Hally who hit a left footed shot just inside the left post from 17 yards out.

3) Aremy Santos scored her 7th goal of the season, assisted by Janet Castillo (2nd assist of season) with 33:37 remaining in the match. Aremy took a corner kick from the right corner which got through all the players and Estela Lupian ran it down near the left sideline. Estela centered a drop pass to Janet, who dribbled around 1 defender and took a 10 yard shot on goal, which was deflected. Aremy crashed the shot and 1 touched the deflection in from 3 yards out just inside the right post.

4) Aremy Santos scored her 8th goal of the season, assisted by Karla Sanchez (5th assist of season) on a shot from 17 yards out with 32:43 remaining in the match. Libby Leon received a throw-in down the right sideline and passed the ball to Karla running the right corner. Karla centered a pass to Aremy just outside the right hash. Aremy hit the shot into the left side net.

5) Aremy Santos scored her 9th goal of the season with 26:50 remaining in the match. Aremy stole a goal kick from Carroll's keeper about 25 yards out. The steal deflected to 18 yards out where Aremy volleyed the ball on 1 touch off the ground from 18 yards out going just under the crossbar.

Carroll scored a late goal on a counter of a D-S possession with a crossing pass from the right wing to the left post resulting in a 6 yard shot.

Comments by Coach Eller: "We decided to go with 3 forwards and 4 midfielders instead of 2 and 5 in the hopes of creating more shots. We did create more shots, and some of our shots were fantastic shots. We hit shots just inside the post and just under the crossbar for all 5 of our goals. Carroll has a good keeper who saved a lot of our good shots because she has good agility and quickness side to side covering the goal, in addition to being tall. The goals we

scored were shots no keeper was going to get to. We had an emphasis on being more aggressive on offense, both in taking shots when we had space and being more aggressive in attacking the defense when we had 1 on 1 opportunities instead of regularly looking to pass the ball in those situations. Our passing continues to be a work in progress, but at least we are looking to possess the ball with short passes. We did have some really good passes over the top of the defense and wide down the sideline to create some goals and good shots for us. We played with more confidence tonight than we had played with the past 8 games. We need to continue that aggressiveness on offense the rest of the season. Our defense and goalkeeping were very solid again".
