Comments by Coach Eller: "We created some good shots, but East Sac's defense and goalkeeper had a great game for them. We did a good job of creating some open shots outside of 18 yards out, but unfortunately their goalkeeper saved all of the shots on goal. We got a couple of shots off inside of 10 yards that their keeper saved. East Sac does a good job of playing a defensive heavy game plan by always keeping 6 players back and they made it difficult for us to get shots off inside of 18 yards out. By keeping 6 girls back at all times, it takes away any chance we had at getting 1 on 1s against their goalkeeper on breakaways or counters. They also double teamed anybody who had the ball inside of 18 yards out, so open shots in close were hard to get. When we did possess in their defensive third of the field, they had 10 girls back and had all of our girls marked up well. Defensively, we played very well in stopping their counters and really limiting their shots. The penalty kick shootouts were exciting and the girls were really excited to advance with the win in the shootouts. We had some really well placed penalty kicks that their keeper couldn't get her hands on. Sam's 1st save was a fully extended diving save to her right on a great kick just inside the left post. Very few goalkeepers would have gotten a save on that kick".
