**Comments from the Monarch coaching staff:**

We're really proud of our girls for the way they competed today to come away with a fourth place team finish. We had a tough quarterfinal round where we only won one match, but 7 of our 11 girls were able to battle through the backside of the bracket and wrestle for fifth. Five of those - Alexa Tremblay, Taya Adams, Angie Rivera, Giana Garcia, and Taylor Totten - were all able to secure 5th place (the highest place they could get after losing in the quarters). That's kind of been our MO all season. We aren't a high-flying team that's going to punch a lot of girls through to the finals. We tend to muck it up a bit and win those grind it out style matches on the backside of the bracket when it would be pretty easy to give in, pack your stuff up, and head home for the day. Our girls embrace that and know that they probably aren't going to be seeded super high to start tournaments at this point in their wrestling careers. They're looking to get an upset if they can on the front side and if they lose, they pick themselves up and get to work.

The fourth place team finish was a bit surprising actually with Andrea Alcaraz being our highest individual placer at 4th. We never really talk about team scores throughout the day but when we looked up at the end we were sitting in 4th. We'll certainly take it and it's a testament to our girls' relentlessness and

mindsets.

We head to CAM on Tuesday to wrestle SWAT, Sergeant Bluff-Luton, and Southwest Iowa. We'll have some rematches from today that could absolutely impact our seeding at regionals.
