D-S improves to 1-0 this season

Goals: 1) Manuel Leanos scored his 1st goal of the season with 24:25 remaining in the 1st half. The goal was assisted by Jesse Pena (1st assist) and Jairon Hernandez (1st assist). Pena had the ball in the center of the field and passed the ball to his left to Hernandez. Hernandez then put a pass between a gap in the CBTJ defense to Leanos running the left wing. Leanos hit a shot from 15 yards out on the left wing.

The score at halftime was D-S 1, CBTJ 0

2) Angel Jimenez scored his 1st goal of the season with 11:59 remaining in the match. The goal was assisted by Juan Garcia (1st assist). Garcia had the ball on the right wing and centered a pass to Jimenez, who chipped the ball over the goalkeeper from 10 yards out.

3) Manuel Leanos scored his 2nd goal of the season with 11:00 remaining in the match. The goal was assisted by Jesse Pena (2nd assist). Pena had the ball in the right corner and switched the ball across the field to Leanos, who finished the shot from 5 yards out by the left post.

4) Angel Jimenez scored his 2nd goal of the season with 5:49 remaining in the match. The goal was assisted by Even Jeronimo (1st assist) on a give and go on the left wing. Jimenez scored his goal from 5 yards out.

5) Christopher Ochoa scored his 1st goal of the season with 3:26 remaining in the match. The goal was assisted by Angel Jimenez (1st assist). Jimenez had the ball in the right corner and switched the ball across to Ochoa who headed the ball into the net from 3 yards out near the left post.

Comments from Coach Eller: "The game was a tale of 2 halves. We had a great goal as the result of very good passing just over 5 minutes into the match. However, for the rest of the half we played very selfish soccer as our passing was only straight ahead and we continually tried to dribble the ball through 6 defenders. That didn't work as we were unable to get many shots off the rest of the half. It also kept the possession about 50/50 as we repeatedly lost the ball. Defensively, we struggled to clear the ball way too many times as our defenders were just tapping the ball instead of clearing the ball. In the 2nd half, we played much better as we passed the ball very well and used the entire field. That passing resulted in completely dominating the possession and it created some really good shots for our players. If we continue to play as a team like we played in the 2nd half, we will be tough to beat this year. Defensively, in the 2nd half, whenever CBTJ countered our attacks, we did a good job of shutting down their offense".
