2) Angel Jimenez scored his 3rd goal of the season, assisted by Jesus Hernandez (1st assist), in the 1st half. Hernandez took a shot on goal that their keeper bobbed. Jimenez crashed the goal and tapped in the rebound from 2 yards out.

3) Angel Jimenez scored his 4th goal of the season, assisted by Chris Ochoa (1st assist), in the 1st half. Ochoa passed the ball through a gap in the GC defense giving Jimenez a 1 on 1 with their keeper that he hit from 10 yards out.

7) Angel Jimenez scored his 6th goal of the season, assisted by Chris Ochoa (2nd assist), as Ochoa drew 2 defenders to him and passed the ball to Jimenez who finished the shot from 10 yards out.

GC scored the last goal of the match after D-S had emptied their bench.

Comments from Coach Eller: "This was the best game we have played to date. We had our best passing game of the season as we didn't just force the ball down the middle. We passed out wide and over the top when they pushed up, we played the ball wide with short passes, we switched the ball side to side, and we carried the goal line and dropped. We created a lot of good shots by doing all of those things. Defensively, we need to remember to fall back when the other team is countering and we can't leave the middle of the field open to chase a ball on the sideline. 8) Carroll scored on a counter with 7:23 remaining in the match.

Comments by Coach Eller: "In the 1st half, we could have had many more chances to score but we got caught off sides 6 times. Carroll was offside trapping us and we got caught watching the ball and not watching their defense and the ball. Our guys need to remember to turn sideways to see their last defender's position and the ball. If their defender slides up, we need to slide back and we weren't doing that. Our midfielders need to remember to get rid of the ball at the right time as having too many touches will result in our forwards beginning to make their run and getting offside. Defensively, we continue to get caught up too high on our opponent's counters. We need to do a better job of getting back and need to get it out of our heads that we need to win the ball 50 yards from the goal. Other than that, we played great. Our passing was very good and we did a great job of attacking outside and corners. We got their defense to shift repeatedly and made them pay for that several times. Overall, it was a great day for the Monarch JV boys soccer team".
