Comments from head coach Nick Bradley:

This was a tough night for the Monarch wrestling team. We gave up several positions that we had been handling well. We allowed Glenwood and Kuemper to control our wrists in netral. We have to do a better job of making a move in neutral to truly take someone down. On bottom, we still limit ourselves to 1 move. We have to string 2 and 3 moves together to create scramble situations. We did a much better job on top of looking for wrist and knowing various turns. It has been a long season and it is taking its toll on us. We need to mentally recoup and realize that we only have a few weeks of wrestling left before districts. We have to keep our foot on the gas pedal so we are ready for the tough competition at the Hawkeye 10 tournament and districts in Ames. The coaches have several talking points tomorrow to help improve where we were tonight. Our boys are still eager to learn and get better. They need to trust the process and continue to grow.
